



Lambtown Festival 2026 Skeins and Textiles Competition Information and Rules

Entry Information:

Fees: \$5 for each skein or textile entered, payable online

Fill out [entry form and pay entry fees](#) before end of day Sunday, September 27, 2026

Skeins and Textiles arrival:

- Entries will be received at the Skeins and Textiles Display in Madden Hall at Lambtown Festival at the Dixon May Fairgrounds - Saturday, October 3rd from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. and from 1:30-2:30 p.m. Morning drop off is preferable.
- Only students and volunteers are allowed on the fairgrounds before 9am, and if you are not a student or volunteer, you must pay admission to enter the festival by purchasing a ticket online or at the gate.
- Shipped entries should be scheduled to arrive September 20-30, 2026, and we recommend using tracking. Ship to: Lambtown Festival Fiber Events, P.O. Box 103, Dixon, CA 95620

Judging and Display:

- Items will be on display in Madden Hall shortly after judging is complete on Saturday, October 3.
- Judging will begin at 2 p.m. Saturday, October 3.
- All Skeins and Textile entries will remain on display through 4 p.m. Sunday, October 4.
- Judging will be by Alanna Wilcox. All judge's decisions are final.

Information and Rules:

Do NOT include identifying information when filling out descriptions in entry forms or labels attached to items themselves. Entries need to be anonymous for judging purposes.

SKEINS

1. Weight of the skein must be at least 1 oz.
2. All skeins must be handspun.
3. Skeins should be tied in 4 places.
4. Entries must include description and planned use. What you plan to make with the yarn is important for judging.
5. Description should include: color, weight, ply structure, special technique, fiber(s) used and approximate percentages. Also note whether you processed or dyed the fiber yourself.

TEXTILES (Knit, Crocheted, Felted, Woven Items)

1. Entries must include description of item.
2. For textiles made with handspun yarn, a sample of yarn must be included.
3. If an item is made by more than one person, for example one spinner and one weaver, entry should be in both people's names.
4. Description should include: kind of item (sweater, hat, shawl), special techniques, fiber composition. Please note if this textile is your own design.

The People's Choice Awards for the Skeins and Textiles Competition. Anyone attending Lambtown Festival 12-5pm on Saturday, October 3, may place one vote each for their favorite skein and favorite textile. The People's Choice Awards will be posted by 9am Sunday, October 4.
